Official Troop 51 Uniform Policy

Troop Dress Code Definitions – We always have questions about dress code and which items of the uniform are required when. A summary of the uniform requirements are included below. The goal is to use these definitions more consistently in our communications. If you have questions, feel free to follow up with any of the adult leaders.

Uniform Name	Uniform Purpose	Uniform Includes
Activity Uniform	Typically used for sports or other dress-down activities and summer troop meetings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Scout socks • Scout pants, Scout shorts or presentable jeans • Scout belt • Activity shirt (any scout t-shirt).
Official Uniform	Typically used for most official Scout activities such as Troop meetings, traveling to and from Scout events such as campouts, etc.	Same as above replace t-shirt with uniform shirt <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Scout socks • Scout pants, Scout shorts or presentable jeans • Scout belt • Official uniform shirt (tan button down shirt)
Dress Uniform	Typically used for full dress situations such as a Court of Honor, Board of Review/Scoutmaster Conference, Council dinners, Formal Flag Ceremonies , etc.	Same as above plus neckerchief and sash <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Scout socks • Scout pants or Scout shorts (no jeans) • Scout belt • Official uniform shirt (tan button down shirt) • BSA or Troop neckerchief and slide • Merit badge sash (if at least one merit badge has been earned) or Order of the Arrow sash
